

THE APPRENTICESHIP ROUTE



Apprenticeship allows you to earn money, combining on the job training with study. They can be done to a wide variety of NHS and Healthcare jobs and can be taken at different levels, including intermediate, higher and degree apprenticeship.

You will generally need a minimum of five GCSEs, or equivalent, including English, maths and science or technology, subject of entry grade 4 or above, A level or completion of college.
