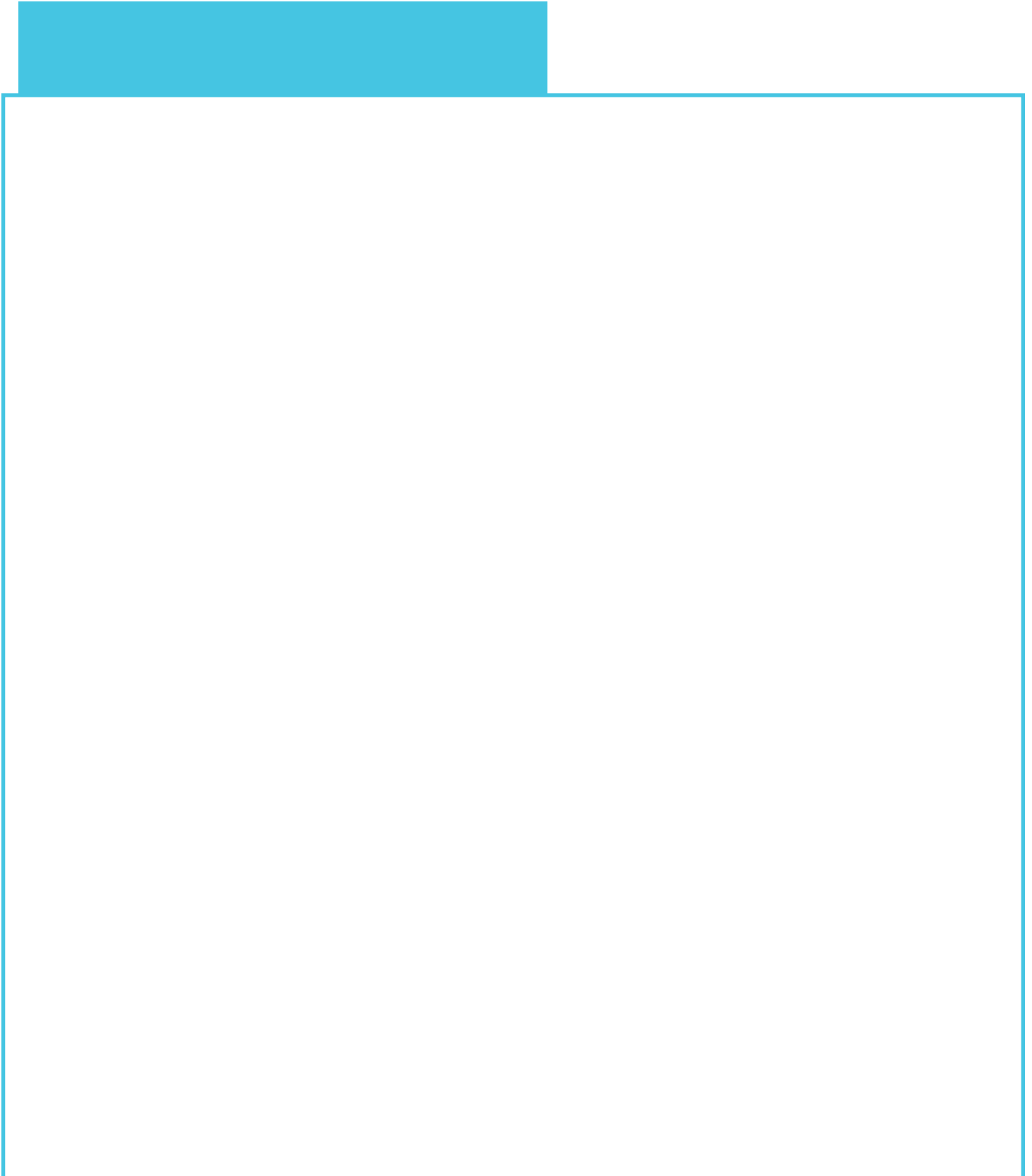

THE UNIVERSITY ROUTE

After completing your A-Levels, T-levels, IB, Highers, BTEC Level or equivalent, you may decide to go on to study a subject relating to Creative Industries at university. Students would usually complete a university course over a period of three to four years. Depending on the subject, these courses combine coursework, exams and practical learning also. It is possible to study your degree part time and in your private time. Students would normally focus on one course which would support their entry into a specific job role.

You will normally find that you will need to achieve GCSE, A level subjects or a vocational course to Level , in order to apply to undertake a Creative Industry related degree at university.
