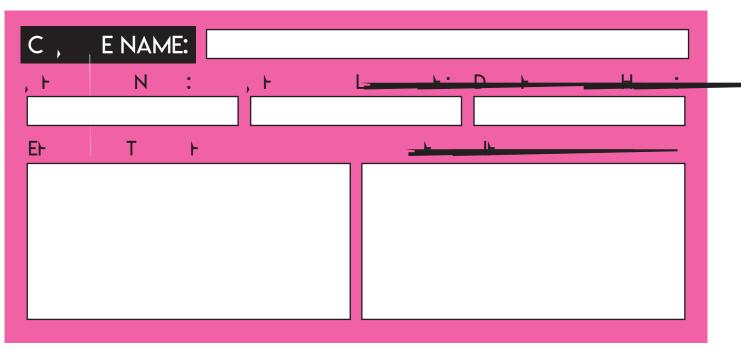
List your 5 favourite courses but ensure you provide the following information about each one:

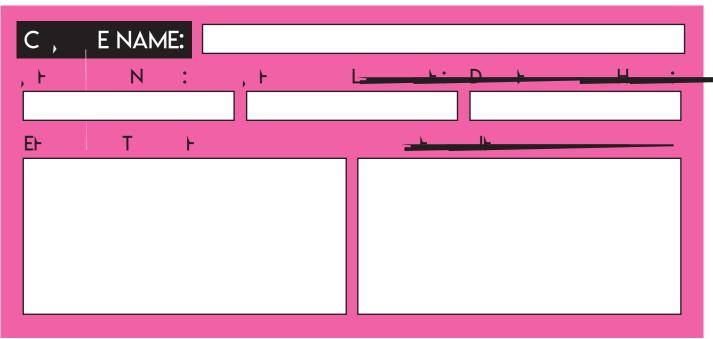
- > Course Name (For example BSc Computer Science)

- > Reasons why the course interests you (Make sure you explore the modules of the course as these are the actual subjects you would be studying)

Your school or college careers teams will help you to apply, but you can make a start by preparing a personal statement.

A personal statement is a piece of writing (4000 characters) that gives you a chance to describe your ambitions, skills and experience to the universities.
