<b>DECISION:</b>	<p><b>Cabinet:</b></p> <p><b>a) Considered the proposed amendments policy for Adult Social Care Services in the following areas:</b></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><b>i) Changing the financial assessment criteria for Replacement Care from a residential service to a non-residential service and making the distinction clearer for service users, and</b></p> <p style="padding-left: 40px;"><b>ii) Implementing charges for both carers when two carers are required to attend a home care visit (double handed care), and</b></p> <p><b>b) Authorised the Strategic Director for People to carry out a public consultation on the proposals, to bring a further paper to Cabinet reporting on the outcome of the consultation and outline his final recommendation for Cabinet approval once the consultation is completed.</b></p>
