

**COMMUNITY AND CONTROLLED SCHOOLS**  
**MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOLS ADMISSIONS POLICY for 2017/18**

When there are more applications than places, in a Community or Voluntary Controlled Middle or High school, children are admitted in the following order of priority:

- i) Relevant \*'Looked after' children and previously \*'Looked after' children.
- ii) Siblings (see below for definition) of pupils attending the school **and** living within the **catchment** area of the school. In order to qualify for a place on the grounds of a sibling attending the school, the sibling must already be attending the school at

decided in the following order, i.e. attendance at feeder school, children of staff, then according to distance, each assessed as indicated above and so on with all other criterion.

Parents/Carers completing an application form for 'In Year' transfers, with a first preference for a Community or Voluntary Controlled School in Worcestershire, must forward the application to Worcestershire County Council, School Admissions Section.
