Background Information

- 2. At its meeting on 18 December 2014, Cabinet delegated final amendments to the detail of the Worcestershire Parkway scheme arising from a public engagement exercise to the Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Economy, Skills and Infrastructure, in consultation with the Director of Business, Environment and Community.
- 3. The public engagement exercise ran from 1 October to 30 November 2014 and sought to provide evidence in support of any future funding applications, identify current travelling patterns and how these might change should the parkway station be built, and to measure the importance of different features of the station. This report makes recommendations regarding if and how the detail of the scheme should be amended in the light of responses regarding these features.
