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1. Introduction

In 2017 Worcestershire County Council undertook a strategic High Needs Commissioning Review to look at the way we commission high needs places and the numbers of children currently in the education system and those forecast to enter our schools. As part of that review the Council worked closely with partners, including local early years providers, schools and colleges and the health service. The strategic document produced was consulted on, including with parents and carers, before being approved in autumn 2017.

The next stage of the review is to now implement its recommendations. This investment plan covers elements of the implementation of the review in respect of the creation of new places or the development of existing accommodation to improve outcomes.

The County Council will work with all types of providers to ensure there is a sufficiency of good quality special education places in Worcestershire.
