

Worcestershire County Economic Summary

Comment: The claimant count decreased in June 2021 by 1,025 to 15,595 and the number of claimants aged 18-24 decreased by 225 to 2,925. Comparisons with March 2020, prior to the impact of the pandemic, show that the claimant count has increased by 7,290 or 88% and the number of claimants aged 18-24 has increased by 1,330 or 83%

1. The Claimant Count includes all Universal Credit claimants who are required to seek work and be available for work, as well as all Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) claimants. Under Universal Credit a broader span of claimants are required to look for work than under
