

Worcestershire County Economic Summary

Comment: The claimant count decreased in August 2021 by 290 to 14,730 and the number of claimants aged 18-24 decreased by 95 to 2,640. Comparisons with March 2020, prior to the impact of the pandemic, show that the claimant count has increased by 6,425 or 77% and the number of claimants aged 18-24 has increased by 1,045 or 66%. Enhancements to Universal Credit as part of the UK government's response to the coronavirus mean that an increasing number of people became eligible for unemployment-related benefit support, although still in work. Consequently, changes in the Claimant Count will not be wholly because of changes in the number of people who are not in work.
