- (a) Looked After Children (LAC), Previously Looked After Children (PLAC) and Internationally Adopted Previously LookedAfter Children (IAPLAC).
 - x A Looked After Child is a child who is in the care of a Local Authority in England or being provided with accommodation by a local authority in England under the definition of the Children Act A989.
 Previously Looked After Old is a child who was looked after but immediately after being looked after become subject to an adoption, a child arrangements order or special guardianship order.
 - x Internationally Adopted Previously Looked After Children are children who appearr de bigge
