Chris Boxall gave an update about SENDIASS (Special Educational Needs and Disabilities Information, Advice and Support Service). They have produced their annual report which will soon be live on the website (Worcestershire SENDIASS). They now have a Training Development Officer to support families and professionals and the team offer lots of different courses.

Young People Advisers are now working in schools and colleges, working directly with young people, and providing career advice.

Diane Hughes gave an update about the Mencap Supported Internship programme. This includes skills development and work experience for up to 30 young people, aged 16-24 years old.

Judy Gibbs (Head of Skills and Investment) told us about an event taking place on 30th March to promote inclusive recruitment and employment to Worcestershire employers.
