Attendance must be at least once per month for at least one year prior to application. Clergy or religious leaders should not be asked to sign forms in support of people who are not known to them, and the Governors request parents/carers only to approach parish priests, ministers or religious leaders if they know that the form can be completed with confidence and sincerity. If you have recently moved into the area, please feel free to seek support also from your previous place of worship.

Please note that membership of the Scouts, Guides or similar organisation alone would not be regarded as Church attendance for the purpose of satisfying admission criteria.
