The services process personal information in order to manage and administer the Green Fingers Project either directly or jointly with partners and commissioned private and third sector providers. This includes:

- x Activities for Looked After, Adopted and Kinship Young People to increase their health & wellbeing, including, Alternative Education, Time Together, Placement Stability, a summer activities programme and one-off activities and events
- x Green Fingers Project service delivery, planning/improvement
- x Community and Leisure service delivery, planning/improvement

## How long we will hold your information

The standard retention period for Looked after Children records is 75 years after date of birth. The standard retention period for adopted children records is 100 years after the date of adoption order.
