	<p><b>Pershore High School being included in the Schools Rebuilding Programme and delegated authority to the Cabinet Member with Responsibility for Education, the decision to publish the statutory proposals for Abbey Park First and Middle School change of age range if a co-ordinated collective solution could be agreed;</b></p> <p><b>e) Noted that Pershore High School is part of the National Schools Rebuilding programme and in June 2023 HM Treasury agreed to include the funding of the expansion of the Year 7 places at Pershore High School as part of this programme to the sum of £22M and that the Department of Education will retain the budget and be responsible for delivery of this project;</b></p> <p><b>f) Noted the timeline of activity for the coordinated change of age range proposals to proceed subject to necessary decision making; and</b></p> <p><b>g) Supported Worcestershire Children First to continue to manage this change and coordinate the area wide consultations with families, residents and other stakeholders.</b></p>
