PART C: DECLARATION

1. Mr E Righton the owner of the land described in paragraph 4 of Part A of this form and shown edged red on the map lodged with Worcestershire County Council on 7th November 2016.

2. On the 7th day of November 2016 Mr E Righton deposited with Worcestershire County Council, being the appropriate council, a statement accompanied by a map showing Mr Righton's property edged red which stated that:

the ways shown blue on that map had been dedicated as footpaths.

No other ways had been dedicated as highways over Mr Righton's property.

4. No additional ways have been dedicated over the land edged red on the map referenced in paragraph I above since the statement dated 7th November 2016 referred to in paragraph 2 above other than those footpaths marked in blue on that map lodged with Worcestershire County Council on 7th November 2016 and at the present time Mr Righton has no intention of dedicating any more public rights of way over the property.

PART D: Statement under section 15A (1) of the Commons Act 2006

PART E:

Footpath route EC-518 commences adjacent to the farm buildings of Embrook Farm. 518 passes north-west through the farmyard and next field until connecting to footpaths EC-517 and EC-513. 518 is currently obstructed by an agricultural building that was erected some years ago. A permissive path (red) has been created branching off of EC-519 along the northeastern boundary to reconnect with 517 and 513.

After discussions with Worcestershire County Council, it is the intention for the permissive path to become a permanent diversion of footpath 518 when the council have sufficient resources. At the current time the Council do not have the resources to formalise the diversion. In the meantime the application has been placed on the expressions of interest list. On the Council's advice we are submitting a Section 31 (6) to avoid the alternative path becoming a public right of way.

Until the Council has the resources to formalise the diversion there is no intention for this permissive path to become a public right of way. For information purposes the footpaths crossing the land and the current permissive path (red) are shown below [Please note this is NOT the supporting map referred to in the statement but is provided for information purposes only].
