PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP MODIFICATION ORDER 2024

This Order is made by Worcestershire County Council ('the authority') under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ('the 1980 Act') because it appears to the authority that in the interests of the owner of the of the land crossed by the footpath described in paragraph 1 of this order it is expedient that the line of the path should be diverted.

This Order is also made under section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ('the 1981 Act') because it appears to the authority that the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in section 53(3)(a)(i) of the 1981 Act, namely, the diversion (as authorised by this Order) of a highway shown or required to be shown in the map and statement.

The applicant has agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this Order and any expenses which are incurred in bringing the new site of the path into a fit condition for use by the public ('the works to the new site').

Worcester City Council have been consulted about the making of the Order as required by Section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

Articles-By this Order

- 1. The public right of way over the land situated at Worcester and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this Order and described in Part 1 of the Schedule to this Order shall be stopped up on the date of confirmation of this order and thereupon the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement shall be modified accordingly.
- 2. Notwithstanding this Order any statutory undertaker as shall for the time being have statutory powers in that respect shall have the right to open up the land referred to in paragraph 1 to install, maintain or alter their apparatus.
- 3. There shall on the date of confirmation of this order be a public bridleway over the land situate at Worcester described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a bold

hatched line on the map attached to this Order and thereupon the County of Worcestershire definitive map and statement shall be modified accordingly.


- 4. The County of Worcestershire definitive statement shall be modified as described in Part 4 of the schedule of this Order.
- 5. The rights conferred on the public under this Order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.


