

Dear Worcestershire County Council Planning Team,

I am writing to you regarding the proposed development at the site of the former Lea Castle, located on the corner of the A1009 and A1100 roads, Worcester, Worcestershire. The site is currently a quarry and is proposed to be developed into a residential estate of approximately 100 dwellings. The development is subject to a planning application (ref: 20/0110) and is currently under consideration by the Council.

3. Noise Pollution and Disturbance:

The constant noise from quarry machinery, along with heavy truck movements, will create an intrusive environment for nearby schools, families, and residents. This disruption level is unsuitable for an area with new homes and a community focused on a peaceful, safe lifestyle.

With the proposed development, the additional trucks on local roads could endanger students walking to school, and the noise and vibration could significantly impact the health and well-being of residents and emergency service access.

5. Long-term Economic Impact:
