with Worcestershire). It is 44 miles away (1 hour 9 minutes' drive in the car) on the opposite side of the major conurbation of Birmingham. Google Maps indicates that this would take over three hours (one way) on public transport on a normal "rush hour" traffic) from the Appeal Site to the location at which the documents would be available.

5. Second, the documents were not hosted in the locality for at least 30 days. The documents were only hosted in the locality during the two public consultation events. This was for a period of (maximum) two days. This is not sufficient to discharge this duty, nor does it give sufficient time for the documents explaining changes to be viewed/read by members of the public.
6. That is significant in a case such as this where the changes are of a substantial technical nature. Members of the public need adequate time to digest changes, not least to enable them to participate fully in the inquiry. No explanation is given for why the documents could not be hosted in the Council's Offices or in the local library (for example, in Kidderminster, which is a 9 minute drive from the Site).
7. The fact that the documents were not hosted in the locality for a sufficiently long period of time (and only hosted online) and only hosted somewhere that would have taken in
