I am writing to express my strong objection to the proposed quarry development at the Lea Castle site by NRS.

This project poses serious risks to our community, environment, and local infrastructure, particularly given its proximity to a school and new residential estate, including our home on Albrighton Drive.

1. Environmental Impact:
